Cluster Sub Harness with Pins for STi Cluster



The first step is getting access to your cluster. To do this, remove the bezel surround using a small screwdriver and unscrewing the two screws in the top of the bezel.



Once unscrewed, the bezel should pop out with a slight pull.




Then unscrew your cluster until you can pull it out slightly and get access to the plugs on the top of the unit. There should be one screw at the top and two screws near each bottom corner.




Unplug the needed connector. (see below for which cluster plug is needed for your specific car).




Next you will insert the wires into the cluster plug. First remove the locks on the top and bottom of the cluster plug to install the pins. You can do this with a small pick or screwdriver.





You'll then insert the pins from the cluster jumper (shown above) into the A cluster plug. These slots should already be empty in your cluster plug. See below for wire order. Slot each pin until you hear a slight click and the pin doesn't pull out with a slight tug.



Once all the of the wires are inserted correctly, use a small pick tool or screwdriver to push in the two locks on top and bottom of the green cluster plug.



To finish you DCCD Cluster install, plug the cluster plug back into the cluster. Plug the white plug end of the cluster jumper provided in your kit into the matching receptacle on your DCCD. Tuck all of the loose wiring behind the cluster. Reinstall the cluster similar to how you removed it. Plug in all wires, tuck them neatly behind cluster, put cluster back into place and reinsert the three screws, push in bezel surround and reinsert two screws to hold it in place.
